Tomorrow morning I (Terry) will be heading to Ukraine again to spend the weekend running team leadership development workshops for a local Operation Mobilization team, and leadership development workshops for a local church, preaching on Sunday morning and then heading home Sunday afternoon.

I will not be near the front lines this time, but in the middle of Ukraine, in a city called Vinnytsia. Please be praying for safety for myself, and for Hanka, Míša and Sam. It is normal that someone gets sick before I travel, and this time is no different - Hanka has been sick all week, even so, tomorrow she will be holding an early "Thanksgiving sleepover" for 20 students at her school (complete with a 10kg turkey!).

Please also be praying for wisdom in what to preach to people whose lives have been turned upside down by the war. I will be preaching a sermon based on Paul's letter to the Philippians which he wrote while in prison. Please also be praying for other Gospel opportunities that this trip may afford - either on the long journey to and from Vinnytsia (over 18hrs each way), or with some of my other clients here in the Czech Republic.

I should get home early Monday morning, so plan on sending out an update some time on Monday, and will include other ministry and life news in the update. (last week I was helping a wonderful ministry in Switzerland plan for their future, and the Gospel choir is going very well!)
