- Give thanks for and pray that God will continue to inspire those who lead and preach that His people will be encouraged to live day by day for Him. To be His Light and Love among our family, friends and community.
- Pray for the oldest and most frail members of our congregation and community – those unable to get to church, those in rest homes, the Bereavement cafe.
- For everyone who walks past our church and sees the banner and thinks about coming in....may they be brave enough to make that first step
- Pray for resources (people and funds) to do all God wants us to do.
- Pray for all the things I've failed to include here!

St Andrew's

- Give thanks for our many children, youth and families and pray for faith to deepen in them!
- Pray that God would provide us with the right Youth Ministry Leader for this next stage of our history.
- Pray for those on Alpha currently and on the post-Alpha basics group that those who are not yet Christians will come to faith and those who are, will deepen their faith.
- Pray for new people to continue to join us, especially those who don't yet know Jesus.
- Pray for our young adults as we seek to gather a group for 20s and 30s. Give thanks for the new young men that have recently joined us.
- Pray for our new Tuesday lunches at the Octagon and other ministry there. For wisdom about the direction for the future.
- Pray for our Lent Course that that would be an opportunity for people to strengthen their 'rhythms with God' in the whole of life.

St Mary's

- Pray that as we currently think about our mission and vision at St Mary's, we will be led by the Spirit each step of the way.
- Give thanks that some local children now come on Sundays to St Mary's and for the newly established Children's Group. Pray for those leading and helping at this group. Pray too for our children's outreach through the year (holiday clubs, craft workshops etc) and that we may see more children (& their families) finding faith.
- Pray for the smooth purchase and instalment of tech equipment that will improve the sound and visuals at St Mary's enabling services to be more accessible for all.
- Give thanks for the 1s and 2s who are recent newcomers to St Mary's and/or faith. Pray that St Mary's continues to be a place of welcome and nurture for all.
- Pray for those preparing for baptism/ reaffirmation of baptism on Easter Sunday (so far two adults and four children).
- Pray for all that happens through the week at St Mary's: the community fridge on Thursdays and Fridays (that has about 50 people accessing it each session), Refresh Community Café on a Friday, Lunch Club on a Tuesday and Toddlers on a Thursday. Pray for accessible stepping stones to faith through it all.
- Pray for inspiration as to how to make our building more visible as a church in the community (not simply a community hall available to book!).
