### **Praying for the Kingdom to Come**

1. *When have you known God telling you to wait for something important? How did it feel waiting and what helped you be patient?*

#### **Read Acts 1:1-14 & Matthew 6:9-10 (30 minutes)**

2. *How do you think the disciples felt after Jesus had ascended to heaven? How would you have felt?*
3. *What do you think the disciples were expecting the Kingdom of God to look like (v6)? Do you think our expectation of the Kingdom of God is different to God's?*
4. *What do you think it means to receive power from the Holy Spirit? What might that mean for you?*
5. *Why was prayer such an important part of the disciples waiting?*
6. *“Prayer is how we align ourselves with the King before joining His mission.” What do you think about this statement?*
7. *What does ‘praying Your Kingdom Come’ practically mean in everyday life? What do you expect and think of when you pray ‘Thy Kingdom Come?’*
8. *What principles can we take from today's reading in our own personal and church lives?*
